ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

General Requirements:

- Length: 1 to 3 pages.
- Formatting: Microsoft Word editor, font size 14 Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing, no hyphenation.
- Paragraph indent: 10 mm.
- Margins: 20 mm on all sides.

Abstract Structure:

- Title (in full, no abbreviations)
- Author(s): Surname, Initials
- Affiliation: Full official name of the institution
- Location: City, Country
- Main Text

Content & Layout:

- Diagrams, graphs, and tables may be included but must be created using built-in MS Word tools.
- The main text must follow this mandatory sequence: **Introduction** (with research rationale), **Objective**, **Materials and Methods**, **Results and Discussion**, **Conclusions**, **References** (if applicable).
- References must be listed in the order of citation. In-text citations should be indicated by a number in square brackets, e.g., [1].

! The authors bear full responsibility for the content of the abstracts and compliance with the **principles of academic integrity**.

INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

1. **Electronic version of the abstract text.**

3. **An anti-plagiarism check report** (similarity certificate).
